Prima parte a lucrării este un studiu referitor la influența limbii franceze asupra frazeologiei românești, realizat pe baza cercetărilor în acest domeniu întreprinse de autor pe parcursul mai multor decenii. Partea a doua este un dicționar frazeologic și etimologic al limbii române care cuprinde unitățile frazeologice din limba română de proveniență franceză. Unitățile frazeologice înregistrate în dicționar sunt explicate din punctul de vedere al sensului și al originii, iar utilizarea acestora este ilustrată cu citate din autori români cunoscuți sau prin referiri la dicționarele românești importante.
