Method: An observational retrospective study was done with the analysis of all PTSC in ACLS courses since 2013 to 2017. Every student had 2 opportunities to successfully complete this task, for those who didn't make it at first we considered for analysis the second one. For each student we've outlined the algorithm that leads to failure. It was considered statistically significant a p-value less than 0.05. Results: During the study timeline Ocean Medical trained 1415 HCP, 177 were excluded due to incomplete data. Were included a total of 1238 students (577 doctors and 661 nurses), with a median age of 31. The successful rate was 70,84% (doctors 404, nurses 473). For those who failed (29,16%; doctors 173; nurses 188) we verified they failed more at cardiac arrest algorithm, on defibrillation rhythms (50,69%), the tachycardia algorithm showed also a failure rate of 27,15%. Limitations: The actual PTSC used in ACLS course does not allow accurate description of the error. Conclusions: We found that most students who failed ACLS course did it at cardiac arrest algorithm, on defibrillation rhythms, followed by the tachycardia algorithm.
